Virginia Louise Jellison Cannon, 72, of Washington, UT, passed away on February 18, 2015 in St. George, UT. She was born May 19, 1942, in Long Beach, CA, to Leland Ramsey and Savannah May Dotson Jellison. She married David Howard Cannon on November 24, 1961, in Reno, NV. They were sealed in the Oakland, CA, LDS Temple on November 23, 1974.

They raised their family in Hayward and Paradise, CA where she was a Dental Hygienist for 18 years. They moved to Ogden, UT, in 1992, where she earned a Masters of Education Degree and she taught Dental Hygiene at Weber State. She is survived by her husband, David, of 53 years; 2 daughters, Kathrine (Charles) Sannar, Heather (Thomas) Tuttle; a son, Leland Cannon; 17

grandchildren; and 12 great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents; a sister, Patricia; a brother, Lester; and a grandson, Aaron Sannar.
