



## Wayne Henning

December 3, 1939 - October 6, 2022

Wayne Henning died at home on October 6, 2022, in St. George, UT.

Wayne was born December 3, 1939, in Rockford, IL and moved to Fort Madison, IA with his family when he was four. Following high school, he went into the Navy, graduating from Electronics Technician school at Treasure Island, CA and subsequently served on the USS Gregory DD-802.

In 1963, he married JoAnn Miller, and they settled in Colorado for 42 years. Wayne spent most of his career in computer software, retiring as a Systems Engineer in 2005. He and JoAnn moved to St. George, UT in 2019.

Wayne enjoyed reading, traveling and photography. He also had quite a fascination with ships and trains, even volunteering at a nearby railroad museum. His kindness and desire to serve others was demonstrated by more than 20 years spent singing in a church music group, the youth bible classes he taught, and his work serving meals to the homeless at the Denver Rescue Mission.

He leaves behind his wife JoAnn, daughter Sandy and her husband Chad, son Steve and his wife Kris, as well as four grandchildren, Devin and Tyler Henning and Connor and Kayla Taggard, plus two great-granddaughters. He is survived by sisters Susan Kalman, Connie Resewehr and Cindy Troast,

plus brother Bill Henning. He was preceded in death by his parents John and Evelyn Henning.
